- 1. Apply harm reduction principles to complex maternity care (social and medical)
- 2. Use appreciative inquiry to establish patient-defined care goals
- 3. Develop a social inventory to map out a care strategy
- 4. Anticipate barriers and stigma that might compromise care for folks with substance use histories
- 5. Identify community partners to help operationalize care goals in a good way

This session will be facilitated by Dr Heather Watson - a psychosocial ObGyn, with fellowship training in the intersections of psychiatric, social and reproductive health. She is also Director of PreClerkship for Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Max Rady College of Medicine at the University of Manitoba.
